Each fountain pen is made by hand in our Urushi studio in Wajima, enhancing traditional inlay techniques with precious metals and lacquer. To blend the old with the new, each fountain pen comes fitted with a Japanese 18K gold nib, over a selection of individually polished Ebonite barrels. And to truly bring historical craftsmanship into your hand, each series is limited and signed by our maki-e artisan.
